Rules for Eligibility

1. Participants must submit a **one-page abstract** of the paper. E-mail submissions will be accepted. The abstract must include the following information at the top of the paper:
 - a) category for which the paper is intended
 - b) title of the paper
 - c) name of the author(s)
 - d) name of the research advisor
 - e) name of the department and university
 - f) student's current mailing address, e-mail address and phone number
 - g) classification (undergraduate or graduate)
 - h) audio/video equipment needs (overhead projectors, TV/VCRs, and computer InFocus projectors)
2. The paper must be the original work of the student author(s). Completed work or work in progress is welcome. A paper which is to be or has been presented by the author at another meeting is acceptable. Papers coauthored by a faculty member will not be accepted.
3. Papers will be presented in the College of Business (10–15 minutes). Audio and visual equipment will be provided upon request.
4. Winning papers will be selected by a panel of judges in each category. Any category with fewer than four participants, we reserve the right to consolidate with one award per category. A minimum of two participants in any category is required for cash awards.
5. The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes to the above.
